The Vaupulans comes close to the Cote de Beaune in its expression of Chardonnay. Saline notes are woven nicely throughout the layers of rich yellow stone fruits. Today, the Vaupulans is singing. Vrignaud aged the Vaupulans in 30% oak, of which 50% was new."	92+
